There is a fee for having your child stay for lunch. Please contact the school if you require further information.

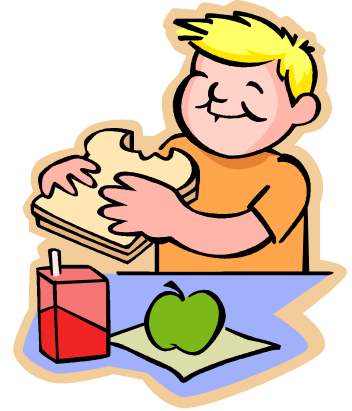
Lunch Registration Form

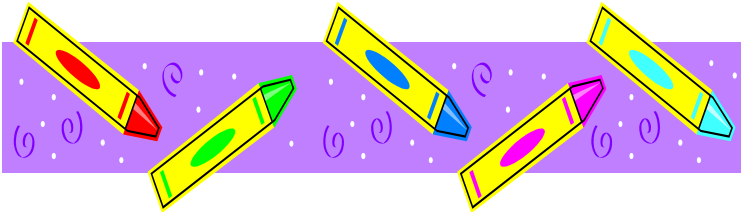
